### E-Books -- SAGE Research Methods

The Library now has access to electronic books in the *SAGE Research Methods* database at [http://srmo.sagepub.com/browse?doctype=srmo\\_book&doctype=gass&doctype=qrm&doctype=majorworks](http://srmo.sagepub.com/browse?doctype=srmo_book&doctype=gass&doctype=qrm&doctype=majorworks). The books cover the following topics:

- Statistics and data analysis
- Survey methods and composition of questionnaires
- Thesis/dissertation writing
- Academic professional development

Many of the books are geared primarily to the social sciences, but they usually have broader application.

Selected titles are cataloged in the Library's WebVoyage catalog and linked to the database or directly to the book.

The database was purchased for all UT campuses by the UT System's Academic Library Collection Enhancement Program (ALCEP).

### Where to Publish Case Reports

Wondering where to submit a case report for publication? George Washington University's Himmelfarb Health Sciences Library has a web page at <http://libguides.gwumc.edu/casereports> that may help. The web page also has

tabs for help with writing case reports and how to publish them. Many of the journals that publish case reports are open access and thus require an article processing charge to be paid by the author.

### Educational Equipment

The Library now has four easels that can be used with or without a T-bar and flipchart. Colored markers are also available.

In addition, the Library has a new 32-inch monitor mounted on a cart for use with our DVD player or a laptop. An HDMI cable is available for connection to the Library's laptop or other suitably equipped devices. USB input is also available if you bring your own cable.

### Historical Books

The Library recently received a donation of medical books dating from 1895 to 1940, including the ninth and tenth editions of Osler's *Principles and Practice of Medicine* and a collection of pre-1909 papers by the sons/co-workers of the founder of the Mayo Clinic. These books and others are stored in the glass-fronted cabinets just inside the Library entrance.
