



ATV Safety

If you are a parent or a guardian it's your duty to make sure a rider knows the rules of ATV safety and how to operate it.

ATVs are only fun until someone is injured or killed.
THESE 8 BASIC RULES CAN HELP
KEEP YOU & YOUR LOVED ONES AROUND FOR THE RIDE.



1. ALWAYS wear a helmet.
2. NEVER ride on any public roads, paved or unpaved.
3. NEVER ride under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
4. NEVER carry a passenger on a single-rider ATV.
5. Ride an ATV that's right for your age and size.
6. ATVs are not toys; supervise riders under 16 years old.
7. Ride only on designated trails at a safe speed.
8. Own the road and your safety. Take a course and know the rules for ATV safety.
