

Hearing Safety

Noise that leaves ringing in your ears or temporary reduction of hearing is too loud!
Sound decibels should be less than 85 decibels.



Did you know these facts about hearing loss?

- Hearing loss from noise is permanent and irreversible
- Causes loss of life quality for farmers and farm families
- Occurs gradually over many years
- Hearing loss from noise can be prevented

7 SOUND SAFETY CHECK OFFS

- Reduce sound levels if possible
- Perform routine equipment maintenance
- Isolate yourself from noise if possible
- Use hearing protection
- Mark high noise zone
- Make sure all hearing protection has a **NOISE REDUCTION RATING**
- Limit daily exposure duration
