Ebooks: A “Hidden” Treasure

In addition to the hundreds of books on the Library shelves, the Library has a few thousand books in electronic format on the web. These ebooks can be identified in the same way that printed books are by searching the Library’s Online Catalog, which is linked from the Library’s web home page.

Though other types of Online Catalog searches can be selected, a keyword search is the most likely method to find book content on a particular topic. A keyword search looks for book authors’ names, words in book titles, words in subject headings, and words in series name and even chapter titles when that information is present.

The Library staff is working to increase the discoverability and accuracy of ebook records and links. And of course ebooks are accessible whether on or off campus. Don’t hesitate to contact the Library if there are any problems with or questions about ebooks.

Literature Searches and Reviews

The health science center’s librarians are trained and experienced at performing searches of the scientific literature. We are glad to provide search services for official professional purposes for faculty, staff, and residents. If you are a student

or intern, the librarians want to help you learn to do your own searches as part of your academic process. Please contact the Library if you want to schedule a training session.

Writing Aids

Need help and ideas on professional writing for theses, resumes, and other professional documents? In the Library’s Online Catalog (linked from the Library home page), do a keyword search on **writing** to get a list of over 60 books and ebooks on the topic. (Ebooks are linked from the Online Catalog.)

UpToDate Registration on Older Smart Phones

If you use an older smart phone that has a small screen, you may not be able to see the parts of the UTHSCT web site screens or the UpToDate home screen when you use your phone to log on to the campus network via a web connection. To avoid this problem, log on to the campus network on a PC or laptop, go to uptodate.com, and register as a user. Then use your smart phone to go to the app store for your type of device, and download the UpToDate app.
